WHEREAS, two weeks' published notice and posted notice of a hearing to be held on November 16, 1964, at 7:00 P. M., on the proposed vacation of the street hereinafter described has been given and made, and a hearing has been held thereon by the Village Council:

GRANDVIEW LIQUOR STORE EQUIPMENT, FIXTURES AND SERVICES PURCHASED.

Clerk presented Affidavits of Publication for Advertisement for Bids - Liquor Store Equipment, Fixtures & Services. Manager presented bids received at 11:00 A.M., Monday, November 9, 1964, being the following: Streater Fixtures, Inc., \$17,833.00; Display Fixtures, Inc., \$18,685.00. During the morning of November 10, 1964, Manager Hyde polled the members of the Council concerning award of bids. Recommendation by Hyde was to Streater Fixtures, Inc., for display shelving, counters, cordial and giftware section, warehouse and stockroom fixtures and equipment, conveyor system, shelving and cooler canopies for total award of \$8,215.00; and to Display Fixtures, Inc. for walk-in cooler and wine room for \$9,893.00; for a total award of \$18,108.00. The members of the Council were polled via telephone, with all stating their approval and with no objections. VanValkenburg moved that the award of these bids be confirmed as presented by Manager. Rixe seconded and the motion was carried.

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
