RESOLUTION VACATING ALLEY
PORTION OF ALLEY BETWEEN BELMORE LANE
AND MALONEY AVENUE AND BETWEEN MONROE
AND MADISON AVENUES

WHEREAS, a majority of the owners of the land abutting on the North-South Alley in Block 12, West Minneapolis Heights Addition and lying between Belmore Lane and Maloney Avenue and between Monroe and Madison Avenues, have petitioned for the Vacation of that portion of said Alley lying South of the North 58 feet thereof; and

WHEREAS, two weeks' published notice and posted notice of a hearing to be had on said petition on June 8, 1959, at 7:00 p.m., has been given and made, and a hearing has been had thereon by the Village Council:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Edina, Hennepin County, Minnesota that

"All of that North-South Alley lying in Block 12, West Minneapolis Heights Addition and lying between Belmore Lane and Maloney Avenue and between Monroe and Madison Avenues, as the same is recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Hennepin County, Minnesota, except the North 58 feet of said alley, shall be and hereby is vacated."
