

ALLEY VACATION 7/11/49
Between Zenith & Abbott & between
W. 56th & W. 57th Streets

Pursuant to "Notice of Hearing on Petition to Vacate Alley," published in Suburban Press, June 30, and duly posted on three Official Village Bulletin Boards, public hearing was held on the petition of Edmund E. Diestler and others, for Vacation of the North-South Alley between W.56th and W.57th Streets and between Abbott and Zenith Avenues South. One property owner, Mr. Addy, objected on grounds of driveway traffic hazard. There were no other objections, and Mr. Addy stated he did not intend to live on this lot. Several home owners spoke for vacation. Willson offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION VACATING ALLEY

WHEREAS, a majority of the owners of the land abutting on the alley herein-after described, in the Village of Edina, Hennepin County, Minnesota, have petitioned for the vacation of said alley; and

WHEREAS, one (1) week's published notice and posted notice of a hearing to be had on said petition on July 11, 1949, at 8:00 P.M., has been given and made, and a hearing has been had thereon by the Village Council:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Edina Village Council, Hennepin County, Minnesota, that

That certain alley running in a Northerly and Southerly direction and lying between the Westerly line of Lots One to Six, inclusive, Block Three, Harriet Lawn Addition and Lots One to Three, inclusive, Block Five, Brookline Addition, and the Easterly line of Lots Four to Seven, inclusive, Block 5, Brookline Addition and Lots Seven to Twelve inclusive, Harriet Lawn Addition is hereby vacated; provided that said Village excepts from this vacation proceeding and reserves unto itself and its assigns an easement for all public utility purposes, including, without limiting the general nature of said reservation, an easement for electric, gas, sewer, water, and telephone equipment on, over and under the center ten feet in width of the alley hereby vacated.
